

#### HONESTY AND TRANSPARENCY

In the meta section, describe where, how, and why you have used AI. This can help you maintain an overview of your AI usage and keep track of what you have written in your own words and what is AI-generated. It can also encourage you to reflect on why you are using it. Perhaps there are alternative methods that might provide you with a better understanding and better results.





### CLEAR REFLECTION:

"ChatGPT was used to draft initial versions of sections on theoretical concepts and to suggest alternative phrasing for key arguments. I chose to quote several of ChatGPT's arguments because they consistently supported my reasoning in the assignment. Furthermore, the tool was used as a sparring partner to outline possible methodological approaches and their justifications."


